

Create a Club

What is a club?

- 10+ LMC students pursuing an activity or interest together
- Recognised and supported as part of LMCSU

Who can run a club?

- Any LMC student can join, run or set-up a club
- Three students must act as the recognised leaders of the club
 - they are responsible for the club's activities
 - they can be elected or merely volunteer
 - they may have defined positions (e.g. Treasurer) or may share tasks
 - they may resign and be replaced with the assistance of the Student Liaison Officer
 - they are accountable to LMCSU and the members of the club

Who can join?

- Any LMC student can join, run or set-up a club
- Some clubs may require joining fees which are payable in cash at the LMCSU Office or Hex

Setting-Up a Club

What will the club do? – What activity or interest to you intend to pursue?

Who will lead the club? - You'll need at least 2 other people to help you run the club

Who will join? - You'll need at least 10 people who are interested in joining

Club Leadership

Any Lancaster and Morecambe College student can join, run or set-up a club.

- may step down and be replaced with the assistance of the Student Liaison Officer,
